Re: proposal to ‘de-amalgamate’ Nottingham Academy

We are writing to ask your view on a proposal that Greenwood Academies Trust (as the proprietor of Nottingham Academy) intends to submit a significant change application to the Department for Education that the primary and secondary phases of Nottingham Academy should be legally ‘de-amalgamated’.

You may be aware that the academy is officially designated as an ‘all-through’ school, even though we operate the primary and secondary phases independently. This proposal would formally create two separate academies. This is a technical change that will not have any material impact on the experience of any pupils currently attending the academy or, indeed, any who will attend it in the future, or any staff member. It will also have no impact on any neighbouring schools.

We do not intend to make any changes to the organisation or admissions arrangements for any phase as part of this proposal. For example, this means that any pupils attending the primary phase of Nottingham Academy in the future will continue to be guaranteed a place in the secondary phase of Nottingham Academy if they want one. The change will merely help us streamline operations and reflect how the schools operate.

In line with the requirements of the Department for Education, we are required to seek the views of relevant stakeholders before we submit our significant change proposal.

We are therefore beginning a four-week consultation period which will run from **1st June to 26th June 2026**.
